SAHIH AL BUKHARI, BOOK 24, HADITH 71

We all face moments where we're tempted to ask others for help and this hadith brings us back to the value of patience and trusting that Allah provides in the best way. "Some Ansari persons asked for (something) from Allah's Messenger^{saw} and he gave them. And then they asked him and he gave them again till all that was with him finished. And then he^{saw} said: "If I had anything. I would not keep it away from you. Whoever abstains from asking others, Allah will make him contented, and whoever tries to make himself self-sufficient, Allah will make him self-sufficient. And whoever remains patient, Allah will make him patient. Nobody can be given a blessing better and greater than patience."



THE POWER OF PATIENCE AND PRAYER

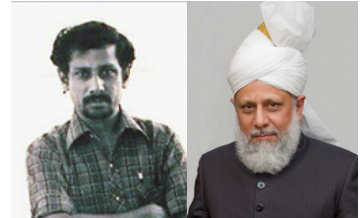
In a powerful reminder, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad^{aba} reminded us of what makes the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community truly unique. He^{aba} directly quoted the Promised Messiah's^{as} teaching that "followers must always show patience and turn to prayer, noting that anyone unable to bear persecution with patience is free to leave." His Holiness^{aba} further quoted the Promised Messiah^{as} regarding how the community will achieve victory. "It will not come from using the weapons our opponents use to attack us. Instead, we will win through spiritual growth: by asking for Allah's forgiveness, learning our faith, keeping God's grandeur in mind, and staying dedicated to our five daily prayers."

HIS FORBEARANCE

A TESTIMONY BY THE RESPECTED WIFE OF HAZRAT KHALIFATUL MASIH V^{ABA}

In northern Ghana (1977), Huzur's life was a quite a lesson in patience. As Manager of the Ahmadiyya Agricultural Farm in Tamale, he became the first in the country to successfully grow wheat – a success earned through long days in the fields and nights spent in village huts during sowing and harvest seasons. He faced every hardship with a grateful heart. At home, his forbearance showed in the smallest acts. Water was scarce, yet after every morning prayer he filled the heavy drums himself, never once asking his wife to do it. When she fell ill, he cooked without hesitation. His example reminds us that patience is not just enduring difficulty – it is choosing kindness and steadiness in every moment.
