JALSA SALANA UK 2026: HIGHLIGHTS, INSIGHTS, AND REFLECTIONS

His Holiness^{aba} said that the preparation and planning of the Jalsa takes months. In fact, preparations for the next Jalsa begin as soon as the Jalsa ends and pick up their pace in the months and weeks leading up to the event.

GRATITUDE TO WORKERS

During the Jalsa, thousands of volunteers and workers, men, women, children and the elderly all continuously strive to serve not only Ahmadis but also non-Ahmadi guests from around the world who are attending the Jalsa. As a result of this service, they are silently conveying the true message of Islam Ahmadiyyat. These volunteers are certainly deserving of thanks, and His Holiness^{aba} prayed that Allah may accept all their work and efforts.



HADITH

Back when helpers were often treated like property, the Prophet^{saw} completely changed the dynamic. He raised their status, teaching everyone to treat them as true equals and siblings. Take a look at this saying by the Prophet^{saw}, narrated by Al-Ma'rur bin Suwaid.

"Slaves are your brethren upon whom Allah has given you authority. So, if one has one's brother under one's control, one should feed them with the like of what one eats and clothe them with the like of what one wears. You should not overburden them with what they cannot bear, and if you do so, help them."

THE PROMISED MESSIAH'S HUMILITY TOWARDS THE NEEDY

During a lecture by the Promised Messiah^{as}, a loud beggar suddenly interrupted his speech. Annoyed by the disruption, one of the members quickly shut the door to exclude the man. However, the Promised Messiah^{as}, after seeing this paused his discourse, redirecting the moment into a profound lesson on humility. He instructed the person to go to his home and fetch something to present to the beggar. He gently reminded him: "It is not good to close the door upon a beggar." This remarkable response demonstrates that Islamic leadership never prioritises its own agenda over the needs of the vulnerable.

EXAMPLE OF TRUE ISLAMIC LEADERSHIP

During Jalsa Salana UK 2026, Mirza Masroor Ahmad^{aba} exemplified humility in Islamic leadership by meeting with guests including journalists and new Ahmadis, from over 60 countries. He personally asked guests for their impressions. One beautiful example was when a concerned Ahmadi from Belize feared a missing national Belizean flag signaled his^{aba} displeasure with their community's spiritual peace. His Holiness^{aba} gently explained that it was simply unavailable and warmly inviting him to bring one next year for hoisting. His response proves that true Islamic leaders serve with deep respect, empathy, and absolute humility.
