

The Strive to Achieve Taqwa

The month of Ramadan has passed by and there will be many who spent Ramadan in worship and making efforts to implement change within themselves but were not able to implement their plans as they wished.

His Holiness^{aba} said that Friday is a blessed day in which prayers are especially answered. If our Ramadan did not go exactly as we planned, or as a believer's Ramadan should be spent, we should still strive in the remaining time left in Ramadan to pray that Allah the Almighty covers our shortcomings and grants us the ability to live our lives in the manner that Allah the Almighty desires for us to. God is extremely Kind; He has not stated that there is a specific time within Friday specifically in Ramadan set for the acceptance of prayer, rather

He has generally stated the importance and blessings of Friday.

His Holiness^{aba} said that if we continue to tread forward in this way and do not allow worldliness to overcome us, then even our limited efforts during this Ramadan will be accepted by God.

THE TRUTHFUL AND THE TRUSTWORTHY

The Prophet^{saw} was born in Mecca in April 570 A.D. He was given the name 'Muhammad' which means, 'The Praised One'.

The Holy Prophet Muhammad^{saw} was pious and forbearing. No one had ever seen him engage in frivolous activities nor had anyone heard him tell a lie. He was always straightforward in all his dealings and conducted business affairs in an easy going and excellent manner. Gradually, his reputation of being trustworthy and honest spread all over Makkah. In fact, people began to address him as Sadiq (the Truthful) and Amin (the Trustworthy). He was given this title when he was still a young man. He was universally respected due to his piety; he also held a high status in the hearts of older and wiser men. When

he became an adult, he adopted his ancestral profession of trade. He began by partnering with other people because he did not possess much wealth and travelled to places like Syria, Basra, Bahrain, and Yemen with his merchandise.

Once a man named 'Abdullah wanted to conduct some business with the Holy Prophet Muhammad^{saw}. While the mutual discussion was being carried on, 'Abdullah remembered some other urgent matter and asked the Holy Prophet^{saw} to stay where he is, and after settle his affairs, will return to him. The Holy Prophet^{saw} answered, "Alright, I will wait for

You." Abdullah left and forgot that he had asked him to wait. Three days later, by chance he passed by the same area and found that the Holy Prophet^{saw} was still waiting for him at that very spot! He immediately recalled his promise and begged forgiveness for the suffering he had caused saying that he had absolutely forgotten. At this, Muhammad^{saw} replied very gently that he had been waiting for him for three whole days.

When the Holy Prophet Muhammad^{saw} claimed prophethood, his people turned against him. In the Holy Qur'an chapter 10

verse 17, Allah says:

"Say, 'If Allah had so willed, I should not have recited it to you nor would He have made it known to you. I have indeed lived among you a whole lifetime before this. Will you not then understand?" meaning that, I have spent a large part of my life among you. Did any of you ever doubt my chastity, my piety, my honesty, and my trustworthiness during that time? When I have spent my youth with such chastity and honesty, would I then, upon becoming older, lie about God?

His Holiness(aba) said that before the partition of Pakistan and India while India was under British rule, there were certain British officers who were against Ahmadiyyat who tried to say that some speeches delivered by the Second Caliph(ra) were inflammatory and they did this to try and incite an attack on him. 
