## The Friday Sermon

*Excerpts from Friday Sermons delivered by Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (aba), the fifth Khalifa (successor) to the Promised Messiah (as) and the supreme head of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.*

## MUHAMMAD<sup>SAW</sup>-THE GREAT EXEMPLAR 10/01/2025

His Holiness<sup>aba</sup> said that in relation to the Expedition of Banu Fazarah, there is mention of the murder of Umm Qirfah. Upon analysing historical accounts, it becomes evident that this is a false incident. His Holiness<sup>aba</sup> quoted Hazrat Mirza Bashir Ahmad<sup>ra</sup> who writes: In place of the above-mentioned Sariyyah of Hazrat Abu Bakr<sup>ra</sup>, Ibni Sa'd has mentioned a Sariyyah wherein Zaid bin Harithah<sup>ra</sup> was the commander. In other words, Ibni Sa'd mentions Zaid bin Harithah as the commander of this Sariyyah instead of Hazrat Abu Bakr<sup>ra</sup>.

Moreover, differing in details as well, he writes that this expedition was to discipline the Banu Fazarah, who resided near the Wadi'ul-Qura' and who had attacked a trade caravan of the Muslims, stealing all of its wealth and goods. The driving force behind this mischievous group was an old lady, named Ummi Qirfah, who was a staunch enemy of Islam. When this lady was captured, a man named

## HAZRAT MIRZA GHULAM AHMAD<sup>AS</sup> DEFENDING ISLAM THROUGH THE PEN

The Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup> claimed under divine revelation to be the Messiah and Mahdi. In 1889, he founded the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community and was always at the forefront of defending Islam.

He authored numerous books, including "[The Victory of Islam](#)," which outlines a divinely ordained strategy to counter the aggressive campaigns of Christian missionaries across the Muslim world. He achieved this through the publication of books, distribution of leaflets, hosting of guests and visitors, replying to letters of inquiry and the establishment of a community (Ahmadiyya Muslim Community).

Through these initiatives, the Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup> was not only effective in defending Islam and the Holy Prophet Muhammad<sup>saw</sup> against widespread slanders but also took an offensive stance by highlighting the fundamental weaknesses within the Christian faith and illustrating how it deviated from the true teachings of Jesus<sup>as</sup>. ## DEFENDING ISLAM-TIME LINE THE CONFERENCE OF WORLD RELIGIONS

The passion to defend Islam was carried on by Hazrat Mirza Mashir ud-Din Mahmood Ahmad<sup>ra</sup>, his second successor and the second Caliph of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.

In 1924, he delivered a speech (read out by Chaudhry Zafrullah Khan Sahib) about Islam at the *Conference of World Religions* in London. He stated that the Holy Qur'an rejects the objection that Islam was spread with force and gave the following verse in the Qur'an: '[there is no compulsion in religion](#)' as proof. He said fighting is only allowed when there are attempts to eliminate and harm

significant initiatives have been undertaken by the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community to spread the teachings of Islam and defend its principles.

In our modern era, one of the most notable initiatives is the [National Peace Symposium](#), which was initiated by the current Caliph, His Holiness Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad<sup>aba</sup>. This event serves as a platform to foster understanding among people of different faiths and backgrounds. His Holiness, also the keynote speaker at the symposium, shares insights on peace, coexistence, and the vital role that Islam plays in today's world. He promotes a deeper understanding of Islam and demonstrates its core message of peace and harmony while addressing and correcting the various misconceptions levelled against Islam. Most importantly, he illuminates pathways to achieving global peace by providing critical guidance for world leaders. The first symposium was held in 2004 at the largest Mosque in western Europe- The Baitul Futuh Mosque.

Islam. Other subjects expounded in his speech in light of Islamic teachings were slavery, usury, polygamy, divorce, moral teachings and life after death. Furthermore, he highlighted divine signs that support the truthfulness of the Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup>. Among the significant evidence presented was a specific vision of the Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup>:

**“** *I saw in a vision that I was standing on a pulpit in the city of London and was setting forth the truth of Islam in the English language, in a very well-reasoned address. Thereafter I caught several birds who were sitting upon small trees and were of white colour and their bodies resembled the bodies of partridges. I interpreted this vision as meaning that though I would not be able to travel to that country but that my writings will be published there and many righteous English people will accept the truth. **”***

The address was well received and the president (Sir Theodore Mersin) of the conference said in his remarks that the Ahmadiyya Movement is a prove that Islam is a living religion. [Friday Sermon, February 28th, 2014](#)



Qais from the party of Zaid killed her...In terms of rationality, it should be known that to imprison a lady who is not convicted of murder and then to kill her in the manner which is related in this narration, is something quite untenable.
